Application Components

- TIS High School Transcript (By TEDA International School)
- Standardized Tests
 - I. TOEFL or IELTS
 - II. SAT or ACT
 - III. Advanced Placement (AP)
- Personal Statement/College Essay
- Letters of Recommendation (By TEDA International School)
- Supplementary Documents (E.g., Financial Statements)
- Application Fee



TIS High School Graduation Requirement

- 4 credits of English
- 3 credits of Math
- 4 credits of Science
- 4 credits of Social Studies
- 8 credits of Electives
 - 1 credit of Language*
 - 1 credit of Art or Music*
- 40 hours of school community service



High School Courses

- **English**: English 9 English 10 American Lit. British Lit. (AP English)
- Math: Geometry Algebra II Pre-Calculus/AP Precalculus AP Calculus BC^
- Science: Biology Chemistry Physics/AP Physics 1 Envi. Sic./AP Envi. Sci.
- <u>Social Studies</u>: World Hist 1 World Hist 2 Human Geo./AP Human Geo Global Issue/AP Comparative Government and Politics
- <u>AP Electives</u>: Biology/Chemistry, Computer Science (2), 2-D Art and Design, Drawing, Music Theory, Microeconomics/Macroeconomics, Statistics/Psychology
- Non-AP Electives: Art (3), Jazz Band, Languages Other Than English (3)



High School Transcript

- 1. **HS Transcript**: a copy of applicant's official record of grades and courses from time of entrance to the end of the latest semester in high school.
- 2. TIS Grading Scale for GPA Calculation: please see the handout (most colleges recalculate GPAs based on their own grading scales)
- 3. Information can be interpreted from the transcript:
 - ✓ Academic *progress* through the high school
 - ✓ The *rigorousness* of courses the applicant have taken at high school
 - ✓ Has applicant continuously challenged himself/herself in academics by fully taking advantage of the resources provided by the high school? (2 AP courses in grade 10; 3 AP courses in grade 11 and 4 AP courses in grade 12)



SAT Suite of Assessments:

- ✓ SAT test is recognized globally
- Sections: English Reading, Math, English Writing and Language Usage
- ✓ WE are an SAT test center (efforts and money saved)
- ✓ WE facilitate students' readiness in SAT through several PSAT testing opportunities.




Understanding PSAT Paper Score Report

SAT Suite of Assessments Testing Timeline








